\*North Dakota returned \$95,886 of their original grant award of \$164,861

\*New York returned \$3,132,059 of their original grant award of \$8,224,337

\*The recovered funds plus the unspent admin. funds were reallocated in August 2010 to the following WIC State agencies for approved ARRA projects as follows:

California: \$699,146 for miscellaneous technology projects.

Texas: \$998,780 for miscellaneous technology projects.

Kansas: \$2,501,555 for miscellaneous technology projects.
